### Cambridge City – North and South localities

Due to rising birthrates there is a pressure on the availability of childcare places in the Cambridge City. This fact sheet contains information to support providers in making decisions about expansion to offer new childcare places.

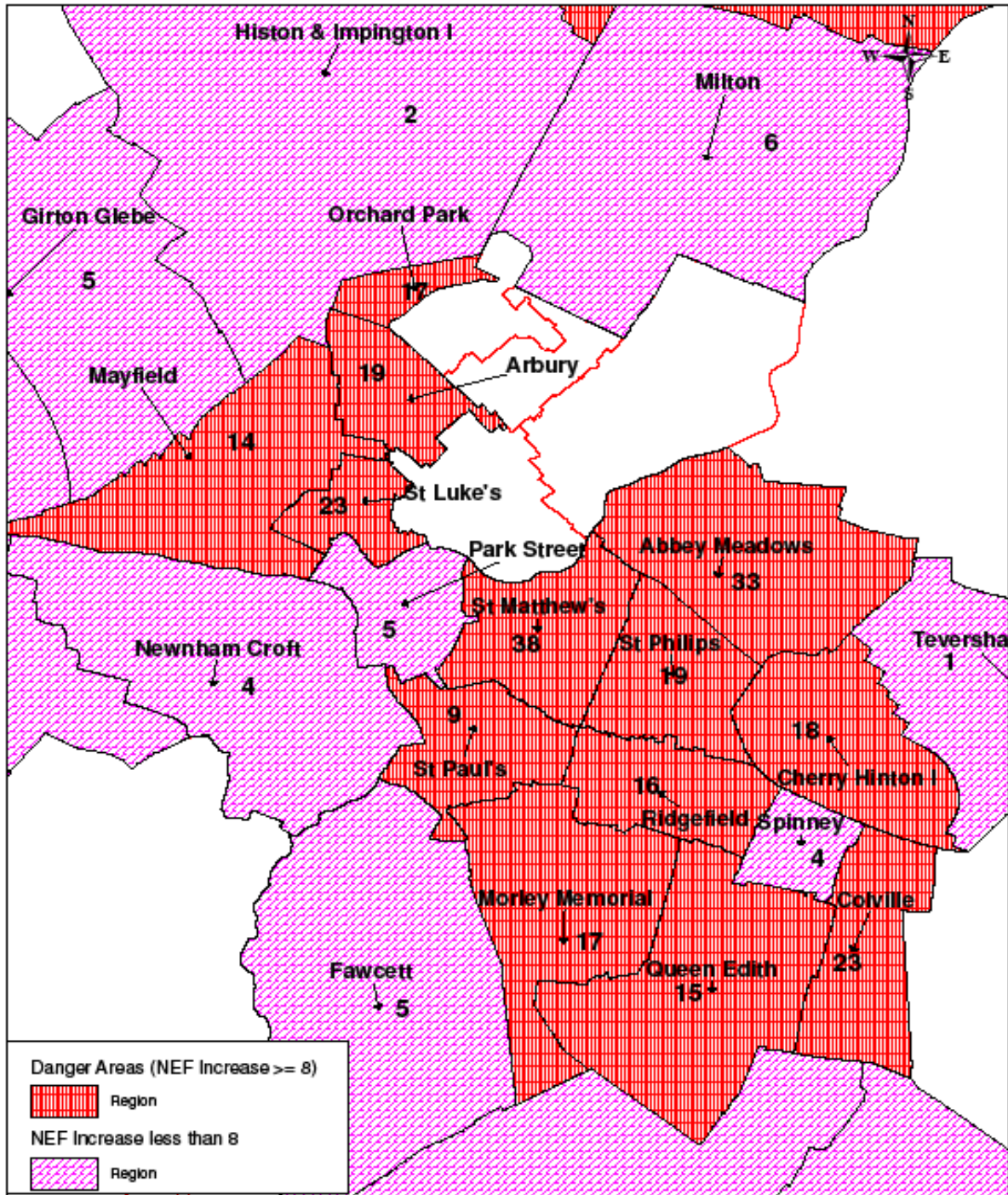
